

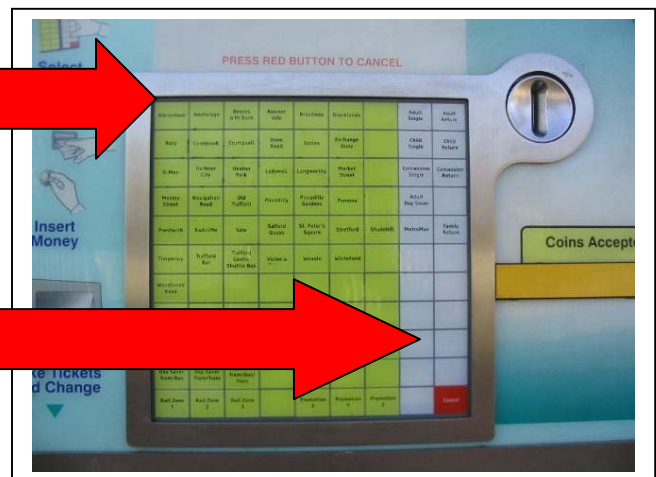
How to purchase a ticket from a Metrolink stop ticket vending machine

Each Metrolink stop has at least one ticket vending machine, if at any time the ticket machine on the platform you are departing from is out of order, please use the machine on the opposite platform.

If you experience any difficulties when purchasing a ticket, such as not receiving your change, then please report this with full details to Customer Services on 0161 205 2000.

Three easy steps to purchase your ticket

From the list of destinations on the left hand side of the machine, select destination, e.g. Piccadilly Gardens.



Select the ticket type you require, e.g. Adult Return/Child Single.



The screen on the machine will display the fare for your journey, insert the money (notes or coins) and the ticket will be deposited into the tray at the bottom of the machine, together with any change. Please note some ticket machines only accept coins.

Other Ticketing Options

MetroMax Tickets

MetroMax tickets offer excellent value for money if you are using the Metrolink system for several journey's within one day/weekend. To purchase a MetroMax ticket:

1. Select the type of MetroMax ticket required, using the ticket type button e.g. MetroMax Family/MetroMax Adult.
2. Select MetroMax from the list of destinations on the left hand side of the ticket machine.
3. The screen will display the cost of the ticket, insert money (notes or coins) and your ticket will be deposited into the tray at the bottom of the machine, together with any change.

Day Saver Multi Modal Tickets

Day Saver tickets to travel on tram/bus, tram/train or tram/bus/train are available after 09.30hrs, to purchase:

1. Select from the yellow keypad the required Day Saver ticket.
2. Select Adult Day Saver on the white keypad (there are no Day Saver tickets available for children). The screen will display the cost of the ticket, insert money (notes or coins) and your ticket will be deposited into the tray at the bottom of the machine, together with any change.

If you wish to travel by Metrolink to a Regional Rail Zone before 09.30hrs you can purchase a combined ticket from the machine.

These are listed on the ticket machines as Rail Zones 1 to 3. First consult the ticket planner poster on the platform to ascertain the rail zone you require.

Select the required zone on the ticket machine keypad and then the adult return or single button.

We regret that multi modal tickets can not be purchased from ticket vending machines within the Metrolink City Centre Zone.
